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21 The Court held a Further Fairness Hearing on September 13, 2021 at 8:30
22 a.m. under the Court's Order on Joint Motion of the Parties for Relief from the Final
23 Judgment Under Rule 60 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure Solely to the
24 Extent Necessary to Include 216 Additional Individuals in the California Disclosure
25 Subclass (the "**Rule 60(b) Order**"). *See* ECF No. 289. After full consideration of
26 the matter, this Court ORDERS the following amendments to the Final Judgment
27 and Order in this action, ECF No. 279, with stricken text showing the original
28 language and underlined text showing the modified language:

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1 Paragraph 11 of the Final Order and Judgment is hereby AMENDED to state as
2 follows:

3 Rule 23(a)(1) is satisfied because the California Disclosure Subclass
4 consists of ~~56,049~~ 56,265 unique individuals, the California EOS
5 Subclass consists of at least 9,699 unique individuals, and the Injunctive
6 Relief Class consists of at least ~~56,049~~ 56,265 unique individuals.

7 Paragraph 17 of the Final Order and Judgment is hereby AMENDED to state as
8 follows:

9 The Court finds that the Parties have satisfactorily implemented the
10 procedures for individual notice to the California Settlement Classes
11 pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, ~~and~~ the Preliminary Approval
12 Order, and the Order on Joint Motion of the Parties for Relief from the
13 Final Judgment Under Rule 60 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure
14 Solely to the Extent Necessary to Include 216 Additional Individuals in
15 the California Disclosure Subclass.

16 Paragraph 23 is hereby AMENDED to add a new subsection 23(j) to state as
17 follows:


18 j. The Email Notice described in the Joint Motion of the Parties for
19 Relief from the Final Judgment Under Rule 60 of the Federal Rules of
20 Civil Procedure Solely to the Extent Necessary to Include 216
21 Additional Individuals in the California Disclosure Subclass was
22 emailed to 216 additional class members, informing them that the Court
23 has approved \$4 million as the amount awarded to Class Counsel in
24 attorney's fees and expenses. The Court confirms that this Email Notice
25 and its dissemination were reasonably calculated to apprise the 216
26 additional individuals in the California Discovery Subclass of the nature
27 of this litigation, the Scope of the California Settlement Classes, a
28 summary of the class claims, that a Class Member may enter an
appearance through an attorney, that the Court would grant timely
exclusion requests, the time and manner for requesting exclusion, and
the binding effect of final approval. There were no objections to the
settlement.

Other than the foregoing amendments as well as any amendments set forth in
the Rule 60(b) Order, the Final Judgment and Order entered in this case, ECF No.

1 279, remains in full force and effect and unchanged.
